WHOLESALE POWER ADJUSTMENT – See "Wholesale Power Adjustment Clause" on Sheet No. 18.0 - Wholesale Power Adjustment - WPA 2002 and the estimated KWH usage based on bulb wattage from the chart below.

KWH USAGE – Wholesale Power Adjustment KWHs shall be determined by the average monthly electrical use on the monthly electrical energy charge table.
