

Mossy Head substation upgrades underway, PowerSouth mobile sub keeps power flowing



To continue improving reliability and meet growing energy needs, CHELCO, in partnership with our generation and transmission partner, PowerSouth Energy Cooperative, has begun major upgrades at the Mossy Head substation. This project will expand the substation's capacity to accommodate the significant growth in the area.


Currently, the Mossy Head substation serves more than 4,000 meters, including the rapidly developing industrial park. During construction, PowerSouth will provide a mobile substation unit to help carry the electric load and ensure members continue receiving reliable power throughout the upgrade process.

"This is a major upgrade for our members in Mossy Head," said CHELCO SVP of Engineering and Operations Matthew Avery. "These proactive improvements are part of our long-term effort to meet growing energy demand and build a stronger, more resilient system for our members."

The upgrades, much like those underway on our Auburn substation, will include new equipment and enhanced technology to improve efficiency, reduce outages and allow CHELCO to better manage electric load during peak times. Once completed, the project will increase capacity to serve new members and ensure the community is well prepared for future growth.

Looking ahead, PowerSouth plans to add a new transformer in 2026, adding 20 megawatts of capacity to the Mossy Head substation. By planning ahead and working closely with PowerSouth, CHELCO is ensuring Mossy Head members can count on safe, dependable power for years to come.

CHELCO's 2025 Youth Tour delegates enjoyed a two-day trip to Tallahassee, where they visited the State Capitol, learned about electric co-ops and made lasting memories.

What is Youth Tour?

Youth Tour is a leadership experience sponsored by CHELCO that gives high school juniors a firsthand look at how electric cooperatives and government work.

This two-day, all-expenses-paid trip in February takes students to Tallahassee, where they'll meet state officials and connect with other co-op students from across Florida.

Everyone who participates in the Tallahassee trip will have the chance to compete for a free, weeklong trip to Washington, D.C., in June. Winners will explore our nation's capital, learn more about the history of electric cooperatives, and sharpen their leadership skills.

How are D.C. winners selected?

Students who attend the Tallahassee trip may enter the competition for the Washington, D.C., tour. Participants will submit a 2-4 minute video highlighting their Youth Tour experience, extracurricular activities, and future goals. The videos will be judged by three impartial judges, and the top four scorers will represent CHELCO in Washington, D.C.
